BOLOGNA AIRPORT'S MAIN CHARACTERISTICS







10.8 million pax in 2024 vs 9.4 million pax in 2019 (+8%) ranking 7th among Italian airports in terms of passenger traffic



Italy's 5th most Connected airport in Italy (101 total destinations in Summer25)



Central geographical location supported by an extensive network of road and rail connections



Serving an area with high standard of living (Emilia Romagna 3rd highest GPD/capita in Italy and Bologna named best city for quality of life in Italy 2020 and 2nd place in year 2023)



Located in a region with strong entrepreneurial spirit



- Passengers exceeded 10m passengers for the first time in 2024;
- Traffic growth from 2014 to 2019 outpacing Italian and EU average growth;
- Pandemic and its shockwave behind us already in 2023 (+6% vs 2019) despite passenger traffic in Europe stood below pre-pandemic volumes;
- Projected air traffic in 2030: ca. **12M pax**.





Accessibility



















